Homecoming Weekend October 17th—19th, 2008

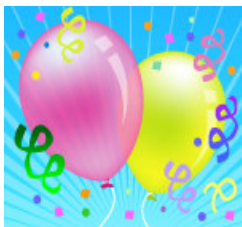
